Marcus Selig is Vice President of Field Programs for the National Forest Foundation (NFF). In his position, he oversees NFF's on-the-ground projects and programs across the 193 million-acre National Forest System, and manages national partnerships with foundations, corporations, individuals, nonprofits, and the U.S. Forest Service for the purpose of enhancing and protecting our National Forests and Grasslands. He has nearly two decades of experience working with government agencies, the private sector, and nonprofit organizations on forestry and environmental issues. Prior to joining the NFF in 2013, Marcus managed Arizona forest programs for Grand Canyon Trust, where he co-chaired the Four Forest Restoration Initiative and led Flagstaff community efforts to establish a \$10M municipal bond for forest restoration. He also spent several years practicing environmental and energy law in Washington, D.C. and as a research scientist at Purdue University's Department of Forestry and Natural Resources.
