

South Subregion

Approximately 82,500 Residents total

Percentage of each county in SNC Area

- Kern (26%=3% pop.)
- Tulare (66%=3% pop.)
- Fresno (44%=2% pop.)
- Madera (58%=20% pop)


South Subregion

- Counties include both Sierra and Valley areas
- Includes Mt Whitney, tallest peak in lower 48
- Highest concentrations of Giant Sequoia trees
- Very steep portion of Sierra
- Most high elevation in federal management
- Most low elevation in private management
- Remote, few roads


