# Important Forms and What To Do With Them

1. **MATERIALS ORDER FORM** - this is the online form to be filled out by the Coordinator to order all necessary supplies for your Cleanup. This form is available on the Coordinator's Corner webpage, [www.sierranevada.ca.gov/coordinators-corner](http://www.sierranevada.ca.gov/coordinators-corner).
  - It needs to be filled out by **MAY 8**.
2. **SITE CAPTAIN FORM** - this is the form that you give to each of your Site Captains.
  - Site Captains fill it out at the end of the Cleanup and call you or report to you, the Coordinator, by 12:30 pm with their info.
  - Site Captains return this form to you.
  - This form should be kept by the Coordinator to use as a guide for the following year.
  - This form **DOES NOT** need to be sent to SNC.
3. **COORDINATOR SITE COMPILATION FORM** - this is the form to be filled out by the Coordinator on the day of the Cleanup.
  - It is a handy form to use as your Site Captains call in/return with their site results.
  - The info for all sites is totaled at the bottom of the form and then called in to the SNC by 1 pm the day of the Cleanup.
  - A copy of the form is mailed to the SNC by **OCTOBER 21**.
4. **CLEANUP WAIVER** - this **REQUIRED** form must be filled out by each volunteer, regardless of age (children younger than 18 need a parent or guardian's signature).
  - The waiver form includes the names of all organizing groups involved in the Cleanup Day. The waiver form needs to be available for review by all volunteers.
  - You will have to make copies for your volunteers. The long signature pages have 10 signature lines per page, so make one-tenth as many copies as the total number of volunteers you will have.
  - Waivers are available in English and Spanish.
  - It may be helpful to your volunteers to include the waiver on your website.
  - **PLEASE NOTE** - there is a **SAMPLE** waiver in this packet - the current version will be available by August 1 at: [www.sierranevada.ca.gov/coordinators-corner](http://www.sierranevada.ca.gov/coordinators-corner).
  - All waivers must be collected by Site Captains, given to the Coordinator, and then returned to the SNC by **OCTOBER 21**.
5. **DATA FORMS & DATA SUMMARY FORMS** - the data forms are given to participants at each site.
  - Volunteers should work in teams (1 person recording info on data forms, 1-2 people picking up trash.)

- Volunteers should include their name and site, and total their tally marks for each type of item on the data forms.
- A volunteer or the Site Captain should tally all cards and enter data into the site's data summary form. The data forms and summary form for each site should be returned to Cleanup Coordinator. The Coordinator (or other organization staff/volunteer) must then total all numbers from each card and record on one additional data summary form representing your entire river/area/watershed. Please be sure to note on this form that the info represents all your cleanup sites. **NOTE:** This info may be valuable to pass on to your city and county officials, as well as to keep track of from year to year for your sites. All data forms and the data summary forms need to be entered into the Ocean Conservancy's database at [www.coastalcleanupdata.org](http://www.coastalcleanupdata.org) by **DECEMBER 1**.
- **NOTE: data forms can be downloaded from the Coordinators Corner webpage or the cardstock version can be ordered on the online Materials Order Form.**

6. **CLEANUP PROGRAM EVALUATION** - this will be a survey emailed to you in October. Please complete by the end of October.

If I intend to use a watercraft in connection with the Event, I also understand the risks related to the acquisition and use of such crafts, including but not limited to risks related to marine facilities, fuels and lubricants, weather, tides, water movement, watercraft operation (including risks related to exertion), collision, water temperature (including hypothermia), sun exposure, swimming proficiency, and rescue efforts. Despite the risks, I still choose to participate in such activity.

No known physical or health limitation prevents me from safely participating in this Event. In Consideration for being allowed to participate, I personally assume all risks, whether foreseen or unforeseen, in connection with the Event of any harm, injury or damage that may befall me as a participant.


